# **Employers Not to Report COVID**

WorkSafe Victoria have amended the incident notification requirements. From 14 January 2022, employers and self-employed persons are no longer required to report COVID cases that attend their workplace, unless the illness is contracted at work and results in a notifiable incident outcome.

Of course, other COVID Safe precautions for workplaces remain in place.
